BIG STEPS ALONG THE PATH TO HEALTH

CEO Leadership Transition

Operations Consolidated

- Payroll Reduced; Some Programs Eliminated
- Moved Child Care to Pine Street Location

Accounts Payable Reduced from \$344,875 to \$196,247

- Almost all LOCAL vendors up to date
- Continuing Discussions with all vendors


Total Indebtedness Reduced from \$5.8 million to \$4.8 million

- Negotiated Several Key Debts
- Sold Wright Street Facility
- Fundraising Targeted at Capital Debt


