1. Called by God

- a. If you aren't COMMANDED by God, don't do it. It is very hard
- b. Bad Reasons to Plant:
 - 1. Couldn't find a job somewhere else
 - 2. Frustrated with the established church
 - 3. "My friends are doing it"
 - 4. Everyone talks about how great it is
 - 5. "People are always telling me that I'd be good at it"
- c. You are a deeply Spiritual person
- d. You passionately love Jesus

2. Apostolic Bent

- a. Entrepreneurial
 - 1. You enjoy starting things
- b. Proven Track record of success and starting and growing things
 - 1. Evangelistic
 - 2. If you can't grow a youth ministry you likely can't start a church
- c. Team builder that creates incredible "buy-in"
- d. Naturally raise up leaders and release people into ministry

3. Secure Person

- a. You are not easily discouraged or offended
 - 1. You are the most "un-offendable" person I have ever met
 - 2. You will have turnover on your team
 - a) Initial team will be gone within 2 years
 - 3. You will lose people for no good reason
 - a) People will check out a new church for a year and decide that it's not for them
 - 4. Other pastors will see you as a threat and undermine you
 - a) "People Are Our Priority" to "Jesus Is OUR Priority"
 - b) Don't fight back
- b. Honor Other Pastors
 - 1. Meet with them
- c. Comfortable in your own skin
 - 1. You don't read the latest book or attend the latest seminar and become something that you're not
 - 2. Be secure in who God made you to be
- d. Church planting is hard
 - 1. The growth process can be very slow
 - 2. It will challenge your self-esteem
 - 3. It will make you question your abilities
- e. You have to believe who you are in Christ
- f. You have to be secure enough to be flexible with everything

4. Courageous person

- a. This is HARD
- b. You're going to want to quit—don't
- c. You're going to want to give up-don't
- d. It is lonely
- e. No one will understand your world
 - 1. You don't relate to other pastors anymore
 - 2. You don't relate to "regular" people anymore
 - 3. Only planters understand planting
 - a) It's a whole different world
- f. Practical advice:
 - 1. Get in the best physical shape of your life

- 2. Start eating healthier
- 3. Develop your stamina
- 4. Get out of debt
- g. Be fearless, courageous, and bold
 - 1. Have a "never say die" attitude

5. Highly driven

- a. You HAVE to work hard
 - 1. Harder than you ever have before
- b. Church planting is not for the "faint of heart"
 - 1. Not for the typical staff pastor
- c. The first 3 years you have to be laser-focused and willing to work long, hard hours
- d. If you have to be extrinsically motivated to work hard and stay focused, don't bother

6. Stable Person

- a. Strong marriage
- b. Supportive kids
 - 1. Struggling kids will be very difficult to sustain while planting
- c. Spiritually growing
- d. Responsible financially

7. Proven Fundraiser

- a. If you can't raise a lot of money, don't plant
- b. You will need to be able to raise \$200,000
- c. You are comfortable making the "big ask"
- d. Under-resourced church plants die miserably slow deaths

8. Culturally Aware

- a. Understand the lost
- b. Love Jesus but speak the language of the culture
- c. Naturally current
- d. Able to see the church from the "outside-in"

9. Attractional personality

- a. People like being around you
- b. People follow you
- c. You have an "entourage"
- d. You have people that are willing to drop things to help you
 - 1. People believe in you
 - 2. Developed a reputation that things happen when you are around
- e. Initially people will become part of the church because the engage with you
- f. If you decided to do something radical, who do you know would join you?

10. Coachable

- a. You can ask for help
- b. You're not so idealistic that you don't listen
- c. You're willing to grow
- d. You're not a "know-it-all"

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
