What is Sonshine Kidfest? It's a community outreach—held once a year—at Anderson Street Park. For several years now, we have partnered with Gracepoint Church (and other churches in the community) to put on this event which provides free school supplies for children, free haircuts and dental check-ups, games, face painting and other fun activities, along with bible stories and Christian music all day long, plus free food—and that's where we come in! Then, at the end of the day, prizes will be given away, along with invitations to accept Jesus. After all, it's all about serving HIM and showing HIM to the community!

We plan to serve 1000 hot dogs along with chips and drinks and need to be gathering our supplies right away. If you are able to donate any of the following items, please see RC Peters by Wed., July 16. (Donated items not received by this date will then need to be purchased.)

10 lbs of onions
150-200 lbs of ice (to cool drinks)

Trucks to carry the supplies
to and from the church to the park
Cash donations will be
accepted to purchase supplies
