THE FOURSQUARE GOSPEL CHURCH BELIEVES IN...

1. **The Holy Scriptures:** We believe the Bible is God-inspired (2Ti 3:16, 17).
2. **The Eternal Godhead:** We believe God is Triune: Father, Son and Holy Ghost (2Co 13:14).
3. **The Fall of Man:** We believe that man was created in the image of God, but that by voluntary disobedience he fell from perfection (Ro 5:12).
4. **The Plan of Salvation:** We believe that while we were yet sinners Christ died for us, signing the pardon of all who believe on Him (Jn 3:16; Ro 5:8).
