#### THE SPIRIT (BREATH)

- Ruaach Hebrew name. It means wind, or breath
- Gen. 2:7 Genesis 2:7 (NKJV)
- <sup>7</sup> And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living being.
- Pneuma Greek name. It also means breath or wind
- John 20:22 (NKJV)
- <sup>22</sup> And when He had said this, <u>He breathed on them</u>, and said to them, "<u>Receive the Holy Spirit".</u>

#### THE SPIRIT ("BREATH")

- Psalm 104:30 (NLT)
- 30 When you give them your breath,\* life is created,
- and you renew the face of the earth.

- Job 33:4 (NLT)
- 4 For the Spirit of God has made me,
- and *the breath of the Almighty* gives me life.

## THE SPIRIT ("BREATH")

• The Spirit of God is the out breathing of God's innermost being. Therefore, when we receive the Spirit, we are receiving the very innermost part of the God of creation. *It* is God dwelling in us in the ultimate sense of intimacy...

• This is most significant for the believer in Christ, because <u>it</u> is the point of our power for living the life of Christ.


- John 3:6–8 (NLT)
- Humans can reproduce only human life, but <u>the Holy</u>

  <u>Spirit gives birth to spiritual life.</u>\* <sup>7</sup> So don't be surprised when I say, 'You\* must be born again.' <sup>8</sup> <u>The wind blows</u>

  <u>wherever it wants</u>.
- Just as you can hear the wind but can't tell where it comes from or where it is going, so you can't explain how people are born of the Spirit."
- This is the <u>Sovereignty</u> of the Spirit!!!!!

- Sovereignty "having supreme power or authority; the status, dominion, power, or authority of a sovereign royal rank or position, royalty; supreme and independent power or authority; rightful status, independence or prerogative...
- The wind blows where it wants to.... Sovereignty
- The Holy Spirit operates as the wind... how He wants to...
- We cannot control either, but we can get in the way, and move with the direction...

- We cannot tell the wind where to blow, and likewise, we cannot tell the Holy Spirit what direction to lead us.
- But we can be directed by the wind of the Spirit when we begin to move in the direction He is blowing.
- It is not for us to instruct the Spirit on how we wish to live, but it is incumbent upon us to follow His leading, wherever it may take us...
- 1 Corinthians 12:11 (NKJV)
- 11 But one and *the same Spirit* works all these things, distributing to each one individually *as He wills*.





- **Exodus** 14:21–22 (NLT)
- LORD opened up a path through the water with a strong east wind. The wind blew all that night, turning the seabed into dry land. 22 So the people of Israel walked through the middle of the sea on dry ground, with walls of water on each side!

- Genesis 8:1 (NLT)
- •But God remembered Noah and all the wild animals and livestock with him in the boat. <u>He sent a wind</u> to blow across the earth, and the floodwaters began to recede.

- **Ezekiel 37:9 (NLT)**
- Then he said to me, "Speak a prophetic message to the winds, son of man. Speak a prophetic message and say, 'This is what the Sovereign LORD says: Come, O breath, from the four winds! Breathe into these dead bodies so they may live again.'"

- **Exodus** 10:13–14 (NLT)
- <sup>13</sup> So Moses raised his staff over Egypt, and *the* LORD caused an east wind to blow over the land all that day and through the night. When morning arrived, the east wind had brought the locusts. <sup>14</sup> And the locusts swarmed over the whole land of Egypt, settling in dense swarms from one end of the country to the other. It was the worst locust plague in Egyptian history, and there has never been another one like it.

- **Exodus** 10:19 (NLT)
- 19 <u>The LORD</u> responded by <u>shifting the wind</u>, and <u>the strong west wind blew the locusts into the Red Sea.\* Not a single locust remained in all the land of Egypt.</u>

The Spirit of the Lord has Sovereignty to move as He wills, and do what He wills, to accomplish the mission of God. Our responsibility is to get in the way of the wind of God, and be pushed into our role in His Sovereign Acts...
