





















Man has been the cause of his ultimate demise...

1. Water 7.

Preservation

2. Food

8. Self-Actualization

3. Clothes 9.

Significance

4. Housing

5. Protection

6. Security

These needs are listed by Maslov in his "Priority Order"...
What is a priority?

A Priority is:

The principal thing

Putting first things first

Establishing the MOST IMPORTANT thing

Primary focus

Placing in order of importance

Placing highest value and worth upon.

First among all others

Priorities determine the quality of our lives.

Priorities dictate our actions and behaviors

Priorities determine our life's outcomes Priorities determine how we spend our time

Time is the currency of life, how you spend it determines the quality of your life... and death. You become whatever you buy with your time Everything around you, wants you to spend it on them...

When your priorities are correct, you preserve and protect your life

Correct priority protects your time.

Correct priority protects your energy, your talents, your decisions, and your discipline.
