Or you may want to check out a resource to view at home. Whether you choose to embark on an individual spiritual journey, meet with a few friends, your Sunday school class or Life Group, you will find something for everyone. Please take the time to fully utilize these resources designed to assist you in your spiritual growth and development. A short description of each of the 100 Bible studies is included in this booklet to help you in your discernment and selection process. **And remember, all this and MUCH MORE is provided at rightnowmedia.org.**

My prayer is that as we view the Rightnow Media Resources, we will experience spiritual growth and renewal. While these resources help to encourage growth in certain areas of our spiritual lives, we must not view these Bible studies as an end in themselves. They are intended to be a means to an end; which is seeing our lives being conformed more and more into the image of Christ. Another way to look at it is to ask, "What does God desire from us?" God wants to be in relationship with us. It is about experiencing God's presence as we fellowship with Him. Two key ingredients in any parent/child relationship involve love and obedience. As parents, nothing touches our hearts more than when our children love and obey us. The same is true with our heavenly Father. We find these two principles clearly communicated in scripture.

The first is found in Matthew 22:35-39 and is called the **Great Commandment**. It states, One of them, an expert in the law, tested him with this question: "Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the Law?" Jesus replied: "'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'"

The second is found in Matt 28:18-20 and is known as the **Great Commission**. It says, Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

I believe that the **Command to Love God and Others** and the **Commission to Make Disciples** is God's primary desire for every single one of His children. In fact, we don't need to wonder what God's will is for our lives-it's undeniably stated in these two passages. But sadly in our spiritual journey, we find ourselves far too often loving the wrong things and doing the wrong things, and how it must break God's heart.

I believe it is time for us to get back to the basics and devote our lives to living out God's Top 2 concerns:

1. Love God / Love Others

2. Make Disciples




1. Pick a Bible study from the Category which meets your need.

7. Contact the church office to play the DVD in your Bible study.










Don't let your students face college unprepared. Be ready. *College Ready*.
