A Sizzlin' Summer in 2010!

As school winds down and summer vacations loom, the church plans for its summer programs. We have a wide variety of plans and activities for the summer months that we want you to experience. We know some of you will be on vacation for some of the time, but we also know how vital it is to stay engaged and active with the church family during the summer too. You can never take a vacation from God. His work continues whether you are here or not, but it is just not quite the same without you.

On Sunday, **June 6**, the church will have a **Graduate Recognition Sunday** and the Lord's Supper. Graduates will have tables highlighting their achievements set up in the MAC for you to view after the service. A reception will be held in their honor. Plan to wish our graduates well as they enter their future studies and careers. The church will be voting on our new **Minister of Music and Worship** on June 6 as well as the slate of **candidates nominated to serve as Deacons** for the term 2010 – 2013. This day will be full of memories and decisions!

On Sunday, **June 13**, at 6:00 PM we will begin our **2010 Summer CLASS: Breaking 150!** During the summer months we have found it to be spiritually uplifting to meet and study a topic together. Our study this year will be led by Shane Johnson and Jean Paul Calixte in the MAC based upon a conference they attended at FBC, Woodstock, GA. We usually meet at 6:00 PM, have a time of discussion based on our study, and then eat and fellowship together for the rest of the time. We want to build up the Body of Christ through spiritual formation and bonds of fellowship. All ages are invited since the Body includes all ages and we learn from one another. This CLASS will be held the second and fourth Sundays of each month. Join us!

GROW outreach continues through the summer months as well. We send out teams twice a month during the summer. A new schedule has been developed and is posted on the church bulletin

board. Summer is a good time to begin the habit of reaching people for Jesus in a non-threatening but effective way. Join us Tuesday evenings at 7:00 PM to reach out to others. The first GROW outreach night is Tuesday, June 1, with Teams G and R leading outreach.

Our **Sunday and Wednesday schedules** are the same but packed with new themes and studies. I will be preaching on basic **Baptist beliefs and practices**. I have had several discussions lately that made me realize that some of our own members are not aware of our Baptist heritage and beliefs. We will also celebrate a time of recognition and giving thanks for our freedom of religion on Sunday, July 4, and investigate the Baptist influence on the principle of the separation of church and state. On Wednesday evenings, from 6:30 PM – 8:00 PM Shane Johnson will teach the apologetics course *Why I Believe!* We will explore the reasons we as Christians believe. Prayer meeting will take place from 6:00 – 6:30 PM in the Prayer Room. We will not have Wednesday dinners during the summer months but the children will be active in **children's choir** as the adults gather to study.

Vacation Bible School begins June 21 and ends June 25. The nightly schedule starts at 6:15 PM and ends at 9:00 PM. This is always an exciting time in our church and many people are involved. We need you to start inviting your neighbors, family and acquaintances to VBS. The theme this year is *Egypt: Joseph's Journey from Prison to Palace*. We need volunteers to make this the best VBS we have ever had. See Shane Johnson, our new VBS director, to find out where you can serve.

Our youth are active this summer too. They will be serving in Vacation Bible School in June. They will be attending Camp Snowbird July 11 – 17 and several youth event outings. Pastor Shane can always use parent helpers and chaperones with these events.

As you can see, summer is still a busy time at Parkview Baptist Church. We need you present for worship, present for duty and present because we love you and miss you when you are not here. Let's make this summer a time of renewal in our walk with the Lord. You can never take a vacation from Him.

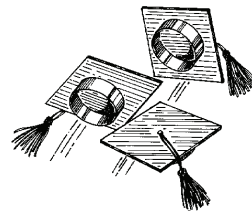

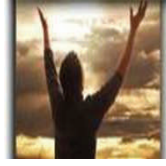
