Imagine all the harm Obama's program will cause. Churches will be hit the most hard. They account for the largest share of the charitable donations, but universities, disease research, hospitals, soup kitchens and cultural institutions will also be hard hit. So will international relief efforts that funnel aid abroad through churches or directly.

This proposal is not about saving money. It is about controlling it - by, in effect, transferring at least \$11 billion a year from private philanthropy to government spending. Obama empowers the public sector at the expense of the voluntary one."
