Review Points Session 2

- 1. The Name Jesus has obtained reflects His redemptive work on the Cross for all peoples. His Name, which is the symbolic presentation of the fullness of His glory, is superior to that of the angels because of Whom He is Son of God, Agent of creation, and because of Whom He has become Son of Man, Savior and Lord.
- 2. The seven OT quotations prophetically speak of the Christ as superior to the angels in both nature and function, attesting to the superiority of New Covenant of grace that He directly mediates between man and God, to the Old Covenant of the Law mediated by the angels.
