HEBREWS 10.1-10

Context: Jesus appeared once on the field of human history to decisively put away sin in the shedding of His blood, atoning for man's sin past, present, and future.

His Church, comprised of those called by His Name, eagerly awaits His return to complete the salvation He purchased for her.

1. We have free and full access to God through Jesus our Great High Priest.
