HEBREWS 13:1 – 14

NIV Passage Title: “Concluding Exhortations” “encouragement”

Chapter 12:28 – “we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken” – how are we to live as Kingdom Citizens today?

Relationships:

Verse 1: Why do we need to be encouraged to “Keep on loving each other as brothers.”?

Verse 2: What does this verse mean to you?

Verse 3: “Remember ... as if” Sympathy or Empathy? How did God show what He feels for us?

Verse 4: “Marriage should be honored by all” Who is responsible for protecting any marriage?
“Adulterate” is a chemical term meaning “to make impure, or inferior, by adding extraneous or improper ingredients; to pollute.”

Verse 5: What do you own? What are you accountable for? To whom are you accountable?

Verse 6: What fearful things can man do to you? What can man NOT do to you? Romans 8:35-39

Verse 7: Leaders – “remember ... consider ... imitate” – how do you live out this exhortation?

Foundation:

Verse 8: “Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.” Fully Human – Fully Divine

Verse 9: How do you recognize “strange teachings”?
