Local Missions

- **Crisis Pregnancy Center** Christ centered care for expectant mothers. Help in collecting baby clothes, preparing meals, work in the office, and annual banquet.
- **Ghent Area Ministry** Assist those in need in the Norfolk community through financial assistance, resources, and services.
- **Hispanic Ministry** We had 42 Spanish students who use books as well as the Bible to learn English. There is also a Bible study and computer course.
- Nickel-A-Meal Funds support our Soup Kitchen and local and overseas hunger funds such as Access Aids, Norfolk Senior Center Prime (Plus), and St. Mary's.
- Norfolk Emergency Shelter Team (N.E.S.T.) For Christmas 2010 we had 560 overnight guests and served 1,130 meals during N.E.S.T. week.
- Norfolk Jail Ministry Volunteers, funds, and materials from FPC provide ministry programs and religious services to the inmates housed at the Norfolk City Jail. So far in 2011 we donated 400 Bibles.
- **Park Place Child Life Center** More than 600 children have taken part in the Center's after school and Saturday programs. Each year some 200 volunteers donate 2,500 hours of service.
- **Soup Kitchen** A hot meal is served each Saturday by a team for the day. Over the year about 4,320 meals are served.
- St. Columba Help to furnish 500+ meals to those in need in Norfolk.
- Video Jail Ministry Host 53 visits of friends/family and incarcerated loved ones.

- Japan Relief Provide funds for hospital relief (medical, food, reconstruction).
- Living Waters In 2011, a team installed a system in Nicaragua. This system will supply clean water for a village!
- **To Support the Greater Church** Support the mission, program, and meeting expenses of the Presbytery of Eastern Virginia, the Synod of the Mid-Atlantic, and the General Assembly.
- **Tree of Lives (TOL)** Tree of Lives opened the Joy Home Orphanage. When full it will house approximately 60 children. Tree of Lives also fights the ravages of HIV/AIDS and poverty in Africa by providing a variety of services to individuals, families, and communities. We serve over 4,000 people with AIDS in the Holy Family Center. We support 3 full-time Christian hospital chaplains; helped hundreds of people who could not pay for their hospital bills; provided for the hunger ministry which touches the lives of hundreds and supported a mentorship program for boys and girls. In addition, we had an Art Therapy Clinic.
- Vida Joven (Nicaragua) A group of 20 people went to Nicaragua and worked in the Help for Nicaragua Medical Clinic and the village of Jinotega. In the clinic there were many opportunities to track the successful growth in patients and furnish medical help. In the village there was building, youth activities, and support for the Vida Joven leaders.
