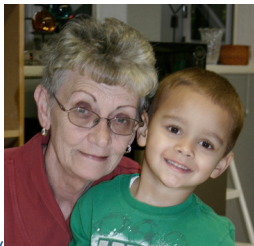


## Mrs. Pam
