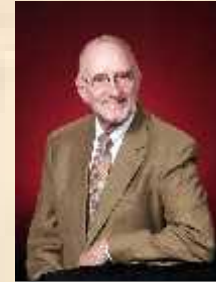

Chicken & Biscuit Bake

From the kitchen of Martha McFarlane

3 c. cooked, shredded chicken
1-1/2 c. chicken stock or broth
1/4 c. butter, melted
2 c. Bisquick
1-12 c. milk
1 10-3/4 oz. cream of chicken soup
1-1/2 c. frozen mixed vegetables, thawed
3 chicken bouillon cubes
Pepper

Preheat oven to 350°. In a small

saucepan, heat stock and bouillon cubes until dissolved. Lightly coat a 9x13 baking dish with cooking spray. Pour melted butter over the bottom of the pan. Layer the chicken over butter. Sprinkle the vegetables over chicken. In a mixing bowl, combine milk and Bisquick; pour over mixture in pan—DO NOT MIX. Combine soup with the stock, blending well. Slowly pour over Bisquick layer—do not mix. Bake 40-45 minutes until top is bubbly and golden brown.
