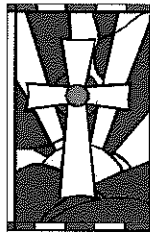

**\*Worship in Singing:** Scriptural varieties of worship are personally expressed by singing.

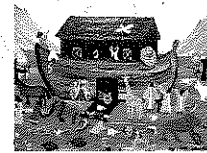
