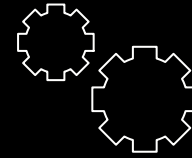
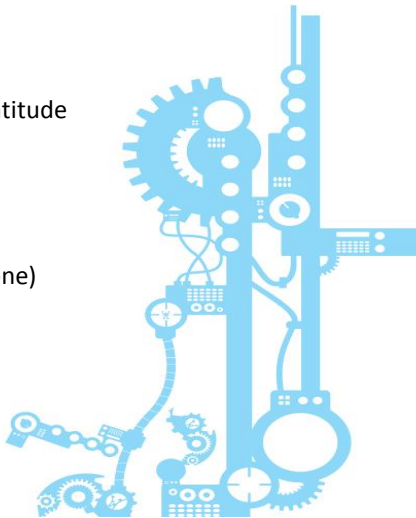
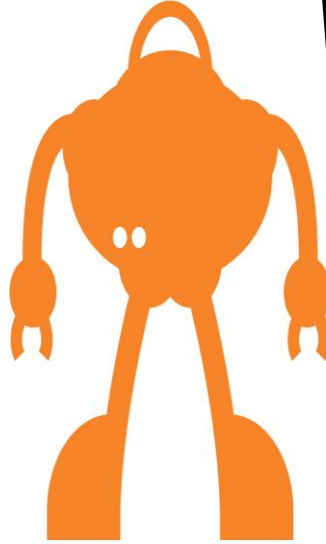
Monday, November 7: Read Genesis 12:2-3.
