God told Adam and Eve that they could eat the animals. (circle one) True False

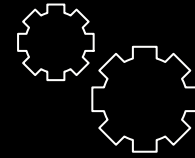
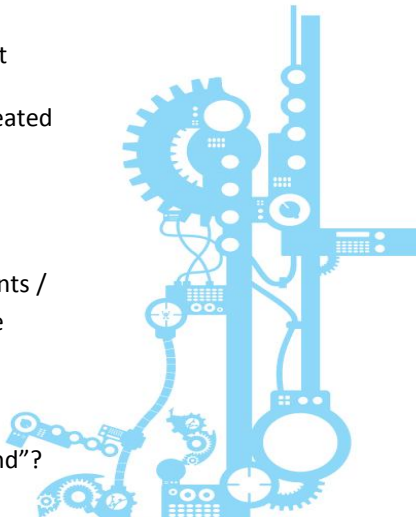
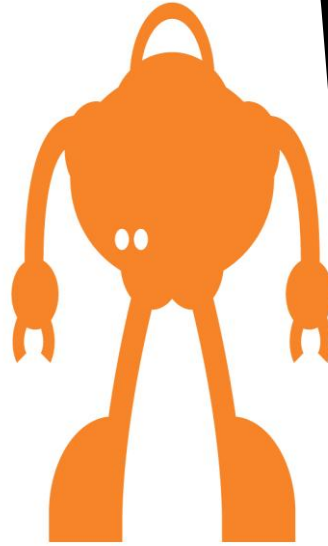
Tuesday, October 11: Read Genesis 1:31 What made this day different from the others? (circle one)
