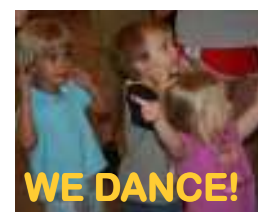
will enjoy some **Olympic type activities outside**. Of course, one day will be spent hanging

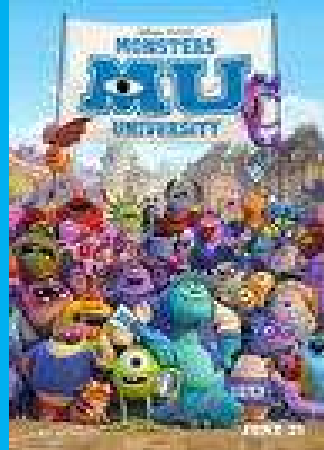
