Exemptions are determined through the evaluation of the student's resume, which must be submitted with the application for exemption along with the high school transcript.

Both undergraduate and graduate studies require the completion of electives a thesis and a comprehensive exam. Additional course requirements will be determined by the student's major (i.e. area of concentration).

Each student's curriculum is individually designed to meet his/her Christian calling or professional goal. The student therefore, has to be self disciplined, goal oriented, motivated and willing to take full responsibility for achieving his/her goal.
