

MOTHER'S DAY OUT

TODDLERS: ***THE LITTLE LAMBS***

AGE: 9 months

HOURS : 9:00am – 1:00pm

RATIO: 5 children -2 adults

DAYS: Monday & Wednesday

The first important stage of human emotional growth is the development of trust. Teachers in the toddler classes are committed to meeting this need in every child by developing a relationship of love, trust, and security.

Children in this class are involved in activities that center on motor and language development. Reading books, naming objects, singing songs, moving to music, and participating in simple “textured” art experiences are a part of this program

Other activities such as taking walks, climbing, and crawling through tunnels help develop large muscles and balance. Interaction with other classmates helps foster early social skills. Lots of personal attention and plenty of “cuddle time” is provided in the toddler program each day!



TWOS: ***THE SUNBEAMS***

AGE: 2 years by September 1st

HOURS : 9:00am – 1:00pm

RATIO: 6 children -2 adults

DAYS: **1)** Monday & Wednesday

2) Tuesday & Thursday

Two-year olds are in a process of gaining control over language, eating, movement, toileting and their environment. This program capitalizes on this developmental phase and strives to help the children become more independent in acceptable ways. Toileting and self-help skills are emphasized.

Language development continues through the use of blocks, stories, music, and community visitors. Plenty of free time is given for the children to choose to explore, examine, and build with objects in their classroom.

Art projects are expanded into activities such as scribbling, finger painting with pudding, and regular painting. Outside time is also enjoyed by the twos. Learning to be with other friends, or sitting on the teacher’s lap are a part of a fun-filled schedule the twos experience each week!

PRESCHOOL

THREES: ***GINGERBREAD FRIENDS***

THREES: ***FROGGY FRIENDS***

AGE: 3 years by September 1st

HOURS: 9:00am – 1:00pm

RATIO: 12 children -2 adults

DAYS: Monday, Tuesday, & Wednesday

Three-year olds are caught up in a world of creativity and imagination. Opportunities for free expression are given in art activities, as well as in creative dramatics as the children act out a poem or song. Opportunities to work in area centers allow freedom of choice and foster social interaction as children begin to “play with” one another.

A group time where discussions, songs, and finger plays are introduced enriches language development in fun and exciting ways. Community visitors are invited to provide the threes with additional learning experiences.

Playing outside or in the playroom is a part of each day. Lunchtime provides a special social time for the children as they end their day. The program provides a chance to explore and learn about our world through both free time and structured activities.



FOURS: ***MARVELOUS MONKEYS***

DAYS: Monday - Thursday

FOURS: ***TEDDY BEAR BUDDIES***

DAYS: Monday - Friday

AGE: 4-5 years by September 1st

HOURS: 9:00am – 1:00pm

RATIO: 14 children -2 adults

Four-year olds are confident and social. This program challenges them to continue learning by providing opportunities to work and play with a variety of materials in unit studies. Each day begins with free choice of various unit-centered activities designed to encourage growth in social, cognitive, and fine motor development. The children then gather for group time where discoveries of the morning are shared, songs, finger plays, stories, and units introduced. Small groups of children and a teacher then concentrate on readiness activities to strengthen pre-academic skills, listening skills, or creative thinking. They may also dictate stories, take a nature walk, or complete an art project. Time to play outside or play in the indoor playroom is provided each day.

The 4-5 year olds experience some unique opportunities such as attending chapel for simple worship experiences. They also travel into the community for field trips to expand their understanding of the world. The program fosters the refinement of readiness skills by providing opportunities for greater independence in preparation for kindergarten.

We want each child to say, “I feel good about myself! I can’t wait to go to school.”

The Preschool Learning Center

The Preschool Learning Center is a community outreach ministry of Fairlawn Baptist Church, which provides a preschool enrichment program in a Christian environment for children ages nine (9) months old to five (5) years old, and a program of outreach to the families of each child enrolled.

We believe teachers and parent of preschoolers are partners with one another and with God to nurture and meet the needs of young children. Children develop best in an environment where they can experience love, acceptance, security, protection, independence, guidance and control. Within this environment, teachers must prepare the classrooms and materials to provide opportunities for the children to explore and learn in a variety of ways to ensure optimum learning.

We believe young children learn by doing and that they acquire knowledge by interacting with people and things in their environment. Our base curriculum, WEE Learn, is graded according to the age of the child to encourage skill development in all areas of growth –social, physical, mental, emotional, creative and spiritual. To accomplish this, we use a variety of methods to enrich the learning environment such as units of study, cooking, learning centers, community visitors, field trips, and experiencing relationships with our special volunteers. Because we provide “hands-on” experiences, most of the knowledge children acquire during our program will not come home on paper, but will, instead be stored in their heads and hearts.

We believe Christian education is important and that children learn about God's love through loving relationships with their parents and other adults outside the family. A Christian environment of love and acceptance, as well as short Bible stories, songs and prayer is a part of our program. All teaching is non-denominational.

Our Purpose

The purpose of our program is not to produce early academics but to provide a comprehensive curriculum in all developmental areas to help “grow” well-rounded children. We want to lay a foundation of knowledge of a loving God and to foster growth in all children to become successful, happy people.
