REGISTRATION

Registration can start by calling us at 903-769-5052 or 903-932-5974 or emailing us at reachcampinfo@gmail. com. Registration is on a first come first serve basis. It will continue each week until the camp is sold out.

In order to guarantee your registration, reservation deposits of \$50 per student/adult must be mailed to:

As registrations are made, please note that we require 1 to 7 adult sponsor to student ratio. When sending deposits, please indicate the total number of participants registering. This number should include all students and adult sponsors coming to camp.

The total camp fee of \$250 includes all expenses while attending camp such as lodging, meals, Bible study materials, quiet time journals, and organized recreation. Any other activities, snacks, additional books, shirts, CDs or food on campus outside of breakfast, lunch and dinner will be an additional cost.

DEADLINES/CANCELLATIONS/LATE ADDITIONS

There will be a waiting list for those churches that miss the deadline. Should space be available Reach Camp will contact your church according to that list.

Deposits for all students and adult sponsors from your church must be postmarked by <u>APRIL 11, 2014</u> and received by Reach Camp no later than <u>APRIL 15, 2014</u>. The deposits are <u>NON-REFUNDABLE AND NON-TRANSFERABLE</u> after <u>APRIL 15, 2014</u>. Reach Camp wants to provide each church with the best possible service and we are accountable to Ouachita Baptist University. Your corporation in meeting these deadlines is greatly appreciated!

Groups cancelling before April 15, 2014 will receive a full refund of deposits. Additional spaces for campers may be requested after the deadline as long as space is available. There will be a \$15 late registration fee adding to your final bill for any late additions.

FINAL PAYMENTS for your church should be in the Reach Camp office no later than June 23, 2014!

Please make sure you have all your final payments in by the deadline as to ensure that we have the correct final numbers and payment to send off to Ouachita Baptist University.



ROOMING LISTS

Your rooming list is just simply a list of all students and adult sponsors that you are bringing to camp. Your list must be separated by Girls and Guys and include all names with what grade they completed and their t-shirt size. For adult sponsors you can put SP instead of a grade completed. Your rooming list is due no later than June 23, 2014 to ensure that we have enough Girls and Guys rooms blocked off for your church attending camp. MEDICAL RELEASE FORMS

All medical release forms must be <u>signed and notarized</u> due to Ouachita Baptist University and Reach Camp guidelines. Only official Reach Camp Medical Release forms will be accepted. Everyone, including students, adult sponsors and church staff members attending Reach Camp must turn in a completed medical release form that is signed and notarized. The original forms will be kept by the Reach Camp staff during camp and will be returned to you during final check out. The medical release forms can be downloaded from our website at www.ReachCamp.org. You will need to make as many copies as you need for your group.

Notaries can be found in most banks, law offices and title companies. There may be a notary in your church who can help you as well.

REACH CAMP CHECK LIST

Please make sure that you, your students and your adults know and understand the checklist of things we ask you not to bring. We want to provide an environment best suited for all of us to meet with The Lord and we ask that you help us by not allowing students to bring things on the "What Not To Bring" list.

- Alcohol or Tobacco Products
- Practical Jokes
- Skateboards/In-Line Skates
- Short Shorts
- Spaghetti Strap Tops or Tanks
- Sleeveless Shirts
- Bikinis (Unless covered by shirt)
- Speedos
- *Laptop Computers
- *IPAD/Galaxy/kindle Fires
- *Cell Phones

*We understand that you and your other adults will need to have your Cell Phones and other electronics, as do we as Reach Staff. We just ask that the students not bring these things as they may be a distraction as they go through the week of camp. Please understand that this is just to provide an environment where they can remove the distraction of internet and social media for a few days and really focus their week toward their time with The Lord!

Any Cell Phone or electronics in student possession will be taken up by Reach Staff and returned at final Check-Out.

ROOM KEY DEPOSITS

Everyone will receive a room key and a key card for their dorm upon Check-in. To ensure keys are returned, the University collects a \$10 bill from everyone attending camp. Please do not bring a check or anything other that \$10 bills for each person in your group. You will receive the \$10 bill back after you turn in your keys and cards during final Check-Out. If your room key or card is lost the University will keep your \$10 to replace them.

REACH CAMP RULES

These are the guidelines you agree to abide by when you sign your medical release forms.

- 1. Always be on time! (Activities are not optional) Late arrivals and/or early checkouts are not permitted
- 2. Be respectful of other groups at Reach Camp
- 3. Damages to facilities will be assessed to the individual church group responsible
- 4. Please do not enter buildings that we are not using
- 5. No one is to leave the campus for any reason except for emergency, doctor or hospital visits.
- 6. Ordering food to be delivered on campus is forbidden.
- 7. Students must obey all University rules
- 8. Students are not allowed to ride in or on any vehicles
- 9. Students must wear their name tags at all times. There will be a \$5 charge for replacing lost name tags.
- 10. The following violations will result in EXPULSION from Reach Camp:
 - Possession or use of drugs, tobacco or alcohol on campus
 - Guys in Girls dorms... Girls in Guys dorms. NO EXCEPTIONS
 - Leaving the campus without permission from the Camp Director, Nurse or Reach Staff
 - Intentional damage to dorms or facilities
 - Being out of dorms after lights out. NO EXCEPTIONS

DAMAGES POLICY

Payment for any and all damages to the camp facilities, including dorm rooms, by a member of your group will be the sole responsibility of your church. Appropriate disciplinary action will also be taken. If damages occur, your church will be invoiced immediately with a detailed list of room numbers and resident names. Payment will be due upon receipt of the invoice.

HOW TO GET THE MOST FROM REACH CAMP

- 1. Be Flexible
- 2. Always Pray! "Lord, do anything in my life you need to do in order to do everything in my life you want to do."
- 3. Always be respectful of those who lead us this week and pray daily they will be obedient to the Lord's leadership.
- 4. When in doubt as to what to do, what to say, or what to wear, ask yourself, "What this Honor The Lord?"

Please make sure that all parents of students attending Reach Camp have a copy of these rules for their records. Make sure to hand them out with the medical release forms.
