



## **Financial Overview**

Once again, Richfield Church gave over 10% of her annual tithes & offerings to local and global ministries. Your sacrificial giving provided almost \$100,000 to support Nazarene World Missions. Missions partnering with our Eastern Michigan District, FMSC, and support to local needs through Eastside Mission and our own Benevolent gifts to help hurting people.

### A New Year of Opportunities...

Our proposed budget for 2017-18 is slightly 2017-18 BUDGET reduced from 2016-17 budget in order to ensure 2016-17 BUDGET another financially responsible year. We expect another year 2015-16 ACTUAL where actual expenditures exceed the budget as generous 2015-16 BUDGET giving, special gifts and some savings enable us 2014-15 ACTUAL to tackle needed projects and expand our serving. \$820,000
