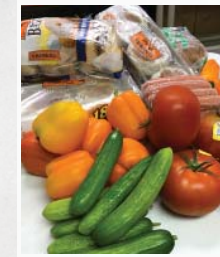

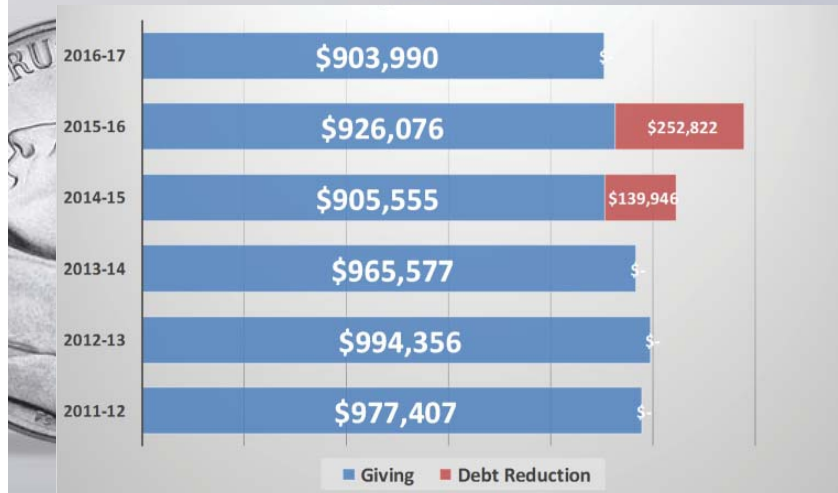


Because You Gave
