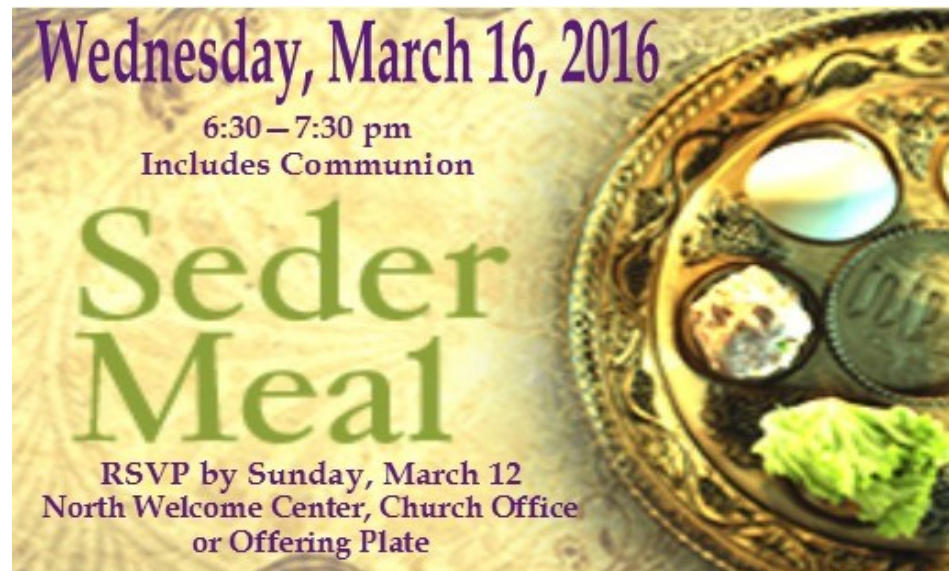

Cancellation Information

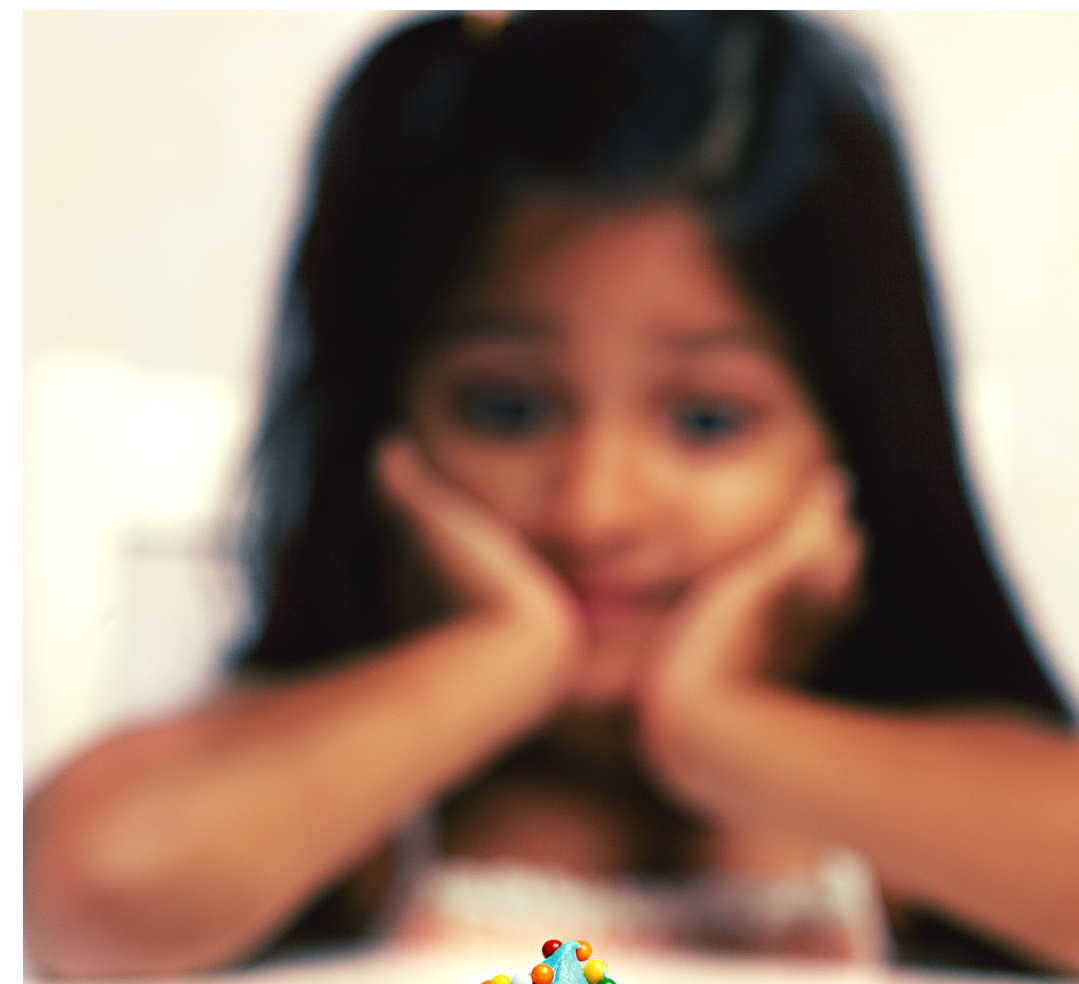
