#### **How to get to Van Buren State Park**

- Take ramp right for I-57 North toward Chicago
- At **exit 345A**, take ramp right for I-80 East toward Indiana (Toll road)
- Bear right onto I-80 E / I-294 S Road name changes to I-80 E / I-294 E
- Keep straight onto I-80 E / I-94 E Entering Indiana
- Keep straight onto I-94 E Entering Michigan
- At **exit 34**, take ramp right for US-31 North / I-196 North toward GD Rapids / Holland
- At exit 13, take ramp right toward Covert
- Turn left onto 32nd Ave / CR-378
- Turn right onto Blue Star Memorial Hwy / CR-A2

Turn left onto 20th Ave / CR-380

Bear left onto Ruggles Rd

#### About South Haven

Founded in 1833 by J.R. Monroe (Monroe Blvd). It is located at the mouth of the Black River on Lake Michigan.

Various festivals are held throughout the year including: Harbor Fest (June), The Annual Art Fair (July), The National Blueberry Festival (August), The All Craft Show (Labor Day Weekend) and The Antique Engine & Tractor Show (September).

- Those interested in boating or fishing will find public boat launch facilities, charter boat fishing and a marina. In the summer, there are free weekly concerts at Riverfront Park.
- For those who enjoy hiking, biking, horse-back riding, cross county skiing and snow-mobiling, the Kal-Haven Trail is located in the nearby city of South Haven. It is a 33 mile former railroad bed and has a lime-stone/slag surface. The trail links the city of South Haven to the city of Kalamazoo. Trial users will pass through small towns, cross over bridges and pass through small towns and pass points of historical interest as they travel through Michigan's beautiful countryside.
