# NYC 2011 District Application Process for Students



## Tiered Program Fee

September 1, 2010 – December 3, 2010 \$450 USD

December 4, 2010 – January 7, 2011 \$500 USD

January 8, 2011 – February 11, 2011 \$525 USD

1. The student completes all required forms which may be downloaded from the district website:

- Application
- Medical/Liability Release (*must be notarized*)
- Personal Reference Form from local pastor or youth leader

2. Student returns the hard copies of above forms to Pastor Steve at their Interview.

3. District interviews and/or approves the student.

4. Upon approval, the district scans the medical/liability release form and emails to NYC office at [events@nazarene.org](mailto:events@nazarene.org).

5. The District NYC Coordinator will receive a pre-formatted Excel spreadsheet to use in compiling a list of the names and email addresses of each approved student. This Excel spreadsheet should be emailed to the NYC Office at the same time the listed students' medical/liability release forms are sent.

- *Each student **must** have a unique email address to be compliant with the registration program requirements—duplicates will not be accepted.*
- **PLEASE NOTE:** *The student will not be able to register online until both the medical/liability form and the Excel sheet have been received by the NYC Office.*

6. The student will receive an email invitation from the NYC Office with a unique URL link to complete their online registration. Payment will be required to complete online registration according to the schedule outlined on the next page.

- *Please note that online registration ends at midnight EST February 11th, 2011*

7. The following online payment schedule has been established for NYC 2011 program fees:

- If registering in the \$450 USD time frame (September 1, 2010 –December 3, 2010), the optional online payment plan below may be utilized:

\_\_\_\_\_ \$150 Final Online payment to NYC due by Dec. 3, 2010

- Payment should be **made in full (\$450)** by midnight EST December 3, 2010.

**If \$450 is not paid in full by the Dec. 3rd deadline:**

- o If full payment is not made by this December 3, 2010 deadline, student is responsible to pay the next tiered program fee (\$500 USD).

- o If by January 8, 2011, full payment is still not paid, student is responsible to pay the next tiered program fee (\$525 USD).

- If registering in the \$500 USD time frame, full payment of \$500 USD is due at time of online registration.

- If registering in the \$525 USD time frame, full payment of \$525 USD is due at time of online registration.

- ***PLEASE NOTE: All payments for NYC Registration (\$450) must be made online.***

8. Full reports showing registration and payment status for both adult and student participants will be available to the district at any time.

**Payments AFTER Dec. 3, 2010 (the additional \$540 for NYC)**

The \$450 you've paid up to Dec. 3rd has gone directly to the registration cost for the NYC event. The additional amount or balance (\$540) now needs to now be paid to the district for the districts portion of NYC.

## Fundraising Information

It is our commitment to work as hard as possible to make NYC happen for your child(ren). I believe wholeheartedly in the ministry of NYC and feel there is no excuse big enough for a student not going. Please look over the Fundraising information and know that there are amazing opportunities to pay for NYC. Personally, my goal is to raise \$450 for each student before Dec. 3rd, 2010!

### **Great American Cafe:**

**(Wednesday Nights)**

This past spring offered a unique opportunity for the Youth Ministry to launch the Great American Cafe. The cafe was open on Wednesday nights and offered a number of fun food options for families. This fall we are bringing the Cafe back bigger than ever! Starting in September we look to relaunch the cafe on Wednesday nights for our people to transition smoothly from work to church.

#### ***How you make money:***

We will need student workers over the next school year to offer their time to work the cafe. Every time a student works the cafe they will earn \$10 towards their trip. There is the possibility of 5 students working each night. There is roughly 40 Wednesday Nights the cafe would be open. 5 students over 40 nights is 200 possibilities to work.

5 nights = \$50      20 Nights = \$200

10 nights = \$100

15 nights = \$150

### **UnBroken Spokes:**

**(Oct. 15-19)**

"We'll Ride for You!" UnBroken Spokes is a benefit ride for students who want to attend NYC in 2011. Youth leaders, and even the District Superintendent (Dr. Brian Wilson) are riding their bikes from Olivet Nazarene University to Louisville, Kentucky.

#### ***How you make money:***

This is an easy opportunity to raise money without even doing anything. The only thing you have to do is ask people to sponsor your youth pastor to ride for you down to Louisville. It's that easy! A sponsorship form, letter, and general information will be mailed out to the students who are attending NYC.

### **Monicals Community Day:**

**(Nov. 8, May 2)**

We have two separate "community days" dates this year. The best part of a Monicals Community day is all you have to do is show up and eat and we make 20% on the bill.

#### ***How you make money:***

This year we are doing something a little different. Because it is next to impossible to know who was where and when, we are going to take the total amount over both nights and divide it evenly among the students.

### All Church Disney Variety Show:

(Friday, Nov. 19th)

Its been a long time since we've had a variety show. It will be an incredible night for the whole family! If you would like to participate in the show all you have to do is sign up and briefly describe your act. There will be a dress rehearsal on Wednesday Nov. 17th from 6:30 to 8:15.

#### ***How you make money***

We are asking all the students who are attending NYC to take part in one way or another for the show. After ticket sales and donations are totaled, the profits will be divided among everyone who worked and attending NYC.

### Domino's Cards:

(Starting in January 2011)

Domino Cards are a great way to earn money for NYC while giving people a little different "taste" than the typical coupon cards.

**Please remember to help people understand that one free pizza is included and the value of the card is worth \$150.**

#### ***Steps/How you make money:***

Step 1: Pre-purchase cards from Steve or Joe for \$5 a card

1 Card	= \$5
5 Cards	= \$25
10 Cards	= \$50

Step 2: Get people to buy the cards for \$15 to help support you to go to NYC

#### **If you sell...**

<u>Cards</u>	<u>Profit</u>
1 Card	= \$10
5 Cards	= \$50
10 Cards	= \$100

## Fundraising Information Cont.

### **Be Unbroken NYC 2011 Wristbands:**

**(Starting in February 2011)**

Wristbands are a great way to not only make a fashion statement, but also promote an important event. Since NYC is the most important event we will do this year, why not have a wristband to remind people where we're going.

#### **How you make money:**

Each band costs \$.60 to purchase and will need to be paid at the time of pickup

Each person will be given 10 bands to sell for \$5 a band or 2 for \$10!

	<b>PURCHASE PRICE</b>	<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>PROFIT</b>
Sell 10 bands =	\$6	\$50 =	\$44
Sell 15 bands =	\$9	\$75 =	\$66
Sell 20 bands =	\$12	\$100 =	\$88
Sell 25 bands =	\$15	\$125 =	\$110
Sell 30 bands =	\$18	\$150 =	\$132 (\$3 from a whole payment)

### **Car Washes:**

**(Saturdays, June 4th and June 11th)**

Pick up your car wash tickets and sell them to as many people as you can. The tickets will be for one car wash ONLY on those dates. These tickets are \$5 and are non-refundable...even if it rains.

#### **Please bring:**

*\*If you sell tickets to the car wash you must show up on June 4th or June 11th to help wash cars. The car wash will be at a participating McDonalds.*

### **Egg N' Beg:**

Last year we included the Egg N' Beg in our fundraising information and there were some people who thought I was crazy. Well, we had a good amount of students who utilized the egg n' beg and raised a good portion of money for their trips.

#### **How you make money:**

Grab a friend, a carton of eggs, go door to door, and tell people you'll smash an egg over your head if they sponsor you. Sometimes people will pay you not to smash an egg on their lawn.
