- When talking in a group, be sure to leave your circle open. This will ensure that your group is accessible and looks ready and willing to add someone to the conversation.

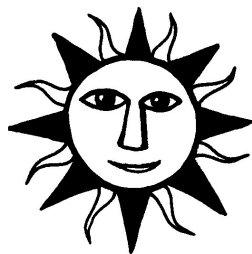

Debris Day at Resurrection
Next Saturday, June 24th

Dear Congregation:

We are planning to use **Saturday, June 24th** as a day to trim, weed and pick up debris around the church property. So bring your work gloves and plan on shoveling, tree trimming, weed whacking and other fun chores! Time is 9 a.m. until noon.

Planned chores include:

- Trimming orange trees & collecting debris (some ladder climbing involved). Sgt. Chuck Murphy is in charge!
- Pulling weeds in orchard and then applying fertilizer under trees.
- Prune bottom suckers off the cedar trees behind Peter Pan Pre-School.
- Pull and cut weeds along parking lot hillside back to the corner.
- Load debris around mulch piles (behind Pre-School) into truck for hauling to the dump (lots of bending & lifting!).
- See if Keith needs any help adding rows in our vineyard!
- Pick up other debris as needed.
