A Note from our Pastor . . .

We are Easter people! We are a people called to live in the *NOW* thru the power of our resurrected Lord. Not fretting over the past or filled with anxiety and worry about the future... but alive and living in the present!

That is why I loved the following quote I came across many years ago via the internet that some of you may have heard in a recent sermon (and many have asked for a copy):



I was regretting the past and fearing the future. Suddenly, God was speaking: **"My name is I AM."**

I waited. God continued: "When you live in the past with its mistakes and regrets, it is hard. I am not there. My name is not I WAS. When you live in the future, with its problems and fears, it is hard. I am not there. My name is not I WILL BE. When you live in the moment, it is not hard. I am here. My name is <u>I AM</u>."

To live in the moment -- neither regretting the past or fearing the future – this is my prayer for us as the people of God.

This month has two important dates: Ascension on May 17th and Pentecost on May 27th. I hope you will join us on those

dates. Pentecost occurred ten days after Jesus ascended into heaven, when his followers gathered together in Jerusalem. While they were indoors praying, the disciples were suddenly empowered to proclaim the risen Christ. They began preaching with boldness and vigor, and by a miracle of the Holy Spirit they spoke in the native languages of the people in the street.

As we head toward the great Pentecost Day celebration, I pray that you are always turning to God for the power of the Holy Spirit, so that you may fully live and spread the love of Jesus. May we never cease to be God's Easter people!
