
SOOOOO....How forgetful are we?

Help is needed in setting up, serving food, and cleaning up. We could also use an additional person to volunteer to do the laundry periodically.



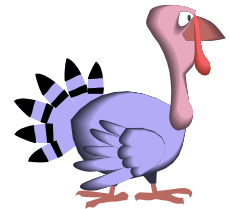
Grace Diner Thanksgiving Buffet

Leftovers



Soon, thanksgiving will be here! We will begin the thanksgiving meal with prayer. When we begin serving the thanksgiving meal, we will have passed the food in a manner that tried to make certain our guests were served first. When the meal has ended and cleanup has begun, we will begin packaging up the leftovers. We divide up the packages so that we can give some to each of our guests to take home with them.

Our lifelong stewardship is much like the thanksgiving meal. We make certain that the first fruits are given to God before satisfying our own needs. At the end of our life, there will be leftover gifts from God which we no longer need as we enter into His kingdom. Before our departure, we package those gifts into a will or trust. We put names on the packages in the way of beneficiaries of financial assets. Was God present at your table during your lifetime? Is God's name on one of the leftover packages?

Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these." Matthew 19:14

As we consider our stewardship as a part of our faith life, it is important that we involve and teach the children. We know that little children love to place money in the offering plate at Sunday service; they watch for the usher and wait for their turn, and enjoy the giving. At home they need to learn why we give money to the church, and a little about what the money is needed for. Then they can learn about sharing some of their money so that the church can provide for God's people.

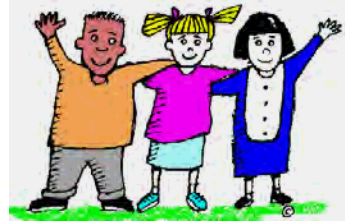

They learn that singing in the choir, or doing liturgical dance is a way that they are giving to the worship service. and that they attend Sunday classes to learn more about God, about prayer and about leading a Christian life. They learn of God's love and all of the blessings we all receive.

Children enjoy having Sunday School envelopes and putting their money in the envelope to give at Sunday School. Envelopes are available for the children here at Grace. As the children are growing and learning, an important part of their awareness can be to share their time and talent and money with the church so that others may receive blessings through them.
