FOUNDATIONS OF OUR FAITH SUMMER BIBLE STUDY 2013

You are invited to study together with other believers as we explore and review the foundations of our faith in Jesus Christ as the Bible teaches us. Please sign the registry for this class so we will know how many to prepare for. The materials are available from Donna at the front desk of the church.

These lessons are divided into seven daily segments. This is a little different from the "usual" 5 day segment studies, but is designed to keep you in God's Word on a daily basis this summer.

I would encourage you to "discipline yourself" to read the Scriptures for each day under the prayerful leadership of the Holy Spirit, and not look to commentary notes or books for your answers. Bring your homework to class each week and we will discuss together what God has been teaching us and/or reminding us through the week. Try also, to "discipline yourself" to cover one section per day, although you may need to double up one day to be finished by our meeting time on Wednesday. We will discuss Week One on June 19.

Begin your daily study of God's Word with this prayer, or your own:

*"Word of God, stir my heart by opening to me the Scriptures as You did to the disciples on the road. I long to know more about You and what You have to say to me through Your Word. Open my mind and give me understanding. Teach me how to relate to Your Word and pray in ways that will please You." In Jesus' name, Amen





How Can Someone Become a Stephen Minister?

The first step is to pray. God has called each of us to ministry. Prayer is one way we learn what ministry God is calling us to do. As you pray, ask God whether Stephen Ministry is the right ministry for you. Think about what gifts God has given you and whether they can best be utilized as a Stephen Minister. You probably won't get immediate answers on this. Prayer is often a journey. Not just one prayer, but many prayers as you search your heart for God's direction for you. Is Stephen Ministry right for you?

A related step is to look at the spiritual gifts God has blessed you with. Not everyone has the gifts to be a caregiver. Among other attributes, Stephen Ministers need to be loving, patient, non-judgmental, confidential, prayerful, encouraging, good listeners, and make themselves available for God to work through them.

A next step is to look at your current responsibilities. Stephen Ministry is a big commitment. Not everyone who has the gifts to be a Stephen Minister can necessarily do so at this point in his or her life. If you are stretched thin already, now is probably not the time to become a Stephen Minister. Or this might be the time to re-evaluate and prioritize everything you are doing, so you can make the two-year commitment to Stephen Ministry.

Another consideration is to look at your own life circumstances—is now the time? For instance, if you are in the midst of the grief process, it probably is better for you to receive care at this point in your life than to become a caregiver. Some of the best caregivers can be people who have worked through their own brokenness, but usually not when they are in the midst of that brokenness.

If you are truly interested, perhaps the best way to find out exactly what is involved and what the joys, challenges, and benefits are is to talk to one of our active or inactive Stephen Ministers or Leaders. Our active Stephen Ministers are (James Ashley, Matthew Barranco, Brenda Helmly, Betsy Hunter, Nanette Kicker, Shannon Moore, Linda Parkany, Ken Parkany, Norman Plourde, and Bonnie Vaughan and Barbara Wild). Our active Stephen Leaders are Pastor Bill Ford, Norm Baker, Stephen Edge, and Marcia Tidwell. In June 2013 Betsy Hunter will attend a Stephen Ministry Leader's Training Course in Orlando FL followed by being commissioned as a Parkway Stephen Leader. After Betsy is commissioned she will replace Marcia Tidwell who plans to go to inactive status. These Stephen Leaders and Stephen Ministers can share their own experiences about what it has been like to serve as a Stephen Minister. They can answer most of your questions about training, serving, supervision, continuing education, and the time commitment involved.

Potential Stephen Ministers go through an application, interview, and selection process. One of the reasons is so the Stephen Leaders can look at all of the above factors with you and help you determine whether Stephen Ministry is right for you at this time in your life. Stephen Minister trainees receive 50 hours of training taught by Parkway Stephen Leaders. Stephen Edge is our Stephen Leader Coordinator for Training. He is responsible, with the help of other Stephen Leaders, for training the next Stephen Minister class at Parkway beginning in August 2013. The Stephen Minister training focuses on Christian caregiving including general topics such as listening, feelings, boundaries, assertiveness, and using Christian resources. In addition, training covers specialized topics such as ministering to the divorced, hospitalized, bereaved, and aging. Stephen Ministers have a two year commitment which includes the training period. We usually train new Stephen Minister classes when we have enough volunteer candidates with the right spiritual gifts. We have recently talked with several members interested in receiving Stephen Ministry training and are looking for additional members who may be interested in starting training in August 2013.

The Role of a Deacon How Can Your Deacon be of Help to You?

Effective deacons lead by encouraging, motivating, and serving others. Acts 6:5

The office of deacon as set for the in Scripture is one of compassion, witness, and service after the example of Jesus Christ. Persons of spiritual character, honest repute, of exemplary lives, brotherly and sisterly love, sincere compassion, and sound judgment should be chosen for this office. It is the duty of deacons, first of all, to minister to those who are in need, to the sick, to the friendless, and to any who may be in distress both within and beyond the community of faith. *G-6.401-G-6.402*

- Visiting with you to "get acquainted". You should always feel comfortable in calling on your Deacon during any illness or at a time of sorrow. Get to know each other before any need arises.
- Rejoicing with you and your family. Sharing your special moments can increase your joy. Let your Deacon know what is going on in your life.
- **Being your friend.** You can count on your Deacon to listen to your troubles and concerns in confidence. It is comforting to know that someone is willing to be there to share your burdens or listen to interesting plans you might have.
- Giving support in a time of crisis. Allow your Deacon to know the difficulties you are facing whether this is financial, marital, loneliness, health or an imminent death. Listening is a special privilege in a Deacon's ministry to you.
- Helping to find answers to questions about faith or our church with its theme of Connect, Grow and Serve. You have a personal resource you can turn to your Deacon. It is better to voice your questions regarding your spiritual life or your concerns about the activities of the church so your Deacon can help clarify and encourage you as a part of the body of Christ at Parkway.
- Guiding you to have a closer relationship with members of the church through fellowship. As you connect with God in the worship services, you also grow spiritually through being a part of smaller groups. Fellowship is offered through Wednesday night meals, Bible Studies mid-week and Sundays, and any number of special interests groups. Find a place that suits you and soon you will put names to faces and share more easily.
- Finding ways to serve within the church. Your Deacon, as a leader in various ministries, is familiar with the places of service at Parkway and the needs that your spiritual gifts can fill. Discuss where you would like to serve as you continue on your journey to Connect, Grow and Serve.

Praying for you and with you. This is a place of importance that your Deacon wants to honor. Let your Deacon know of a specific request from you and be assured that this will be held in confidence.
