## Growing Up Before My Eyes 1 Corinthians 13:1-13

Love is eternal and when one is surrendered to love they will see growth and maturity in them as they grow in God's word. The Corinthian letter tells us how gifts will come and go but three things will remain. "But now faith, hope, love, abide these three; but the greatest of these is love" (1 Cor. 13:13 NASB).
