Pastor Kevin's perspective...

In the Gospel of Mathew, Jesus tells his disciples that they need to go & make disciples of the world. The guestion that we are left with is: how do we make disciples? To figure out how to make a disciple, we have to start by figuring out what a disciple should do. The quick answer is: a disciple follows the teaching of Jesus. However, even the disciples that lived while Jesus was alive had a hard time figuring out exactly what they needed to do.

It is important to have practical ways of living out our own spiritual lives to make a disciple, & I think this is one of the most important areas of growth for any disciple. To help facilitate this, I am offering small group sessions starting this month to work through the book Five Practices of Faithful Living that have been offered by Bishop Robert Schnase, Bishop of the Missouri Conference of the UMC, to review practices that are essential for our growth in Christ. The five topics the small group will revolve around are receiving God's love, loving God in return, growing in grace, loving & serving others, & the grace of giving.

Since everyone seems to have different schedules, these groups will be offered at different times, different days, & even in different ways throughout this year. The groups will start with a 7 week daytime group that will meet on at 9am on Wednesday mornings, starting February 10th. The hope is that additional evening small groups can added at a time that works for many. In addition, if enough people are interested, the possibility of an overnight Friday into Saturday afternoon retreat can be discussed.

I hope that by offering many options, a majority of people in both congregations will be able to attend one of the small groups so that we can work together to make disciples of Jesus Christ, & make ourselves more deeply committed disciples in the process.


