Christian or Christ-Follower?

When I hear that word it tends to be used to describe "churchy" people who are bigoted, judgmental, hateful, mean, & nasty. I hear it referring to "churchy" people who are intolerant of non-Christian points of view & are hypocritical since they don't embody the teaching of Christ.

Since the word "Christian" has become so misunderstood I have been in the process of changing the way *I* speak. I understand that to many people the word "Christian" is a positive word & only refers to people who have turned their lives over to Christ & are now following Christ. This lead me to what I think is a better word than "Christian", & that word is "Christ-follower". To me, "Christ-follower" speaks to what those who believe in Christ say they are doing that is truly following Christ. If we are "Christ-followers" then it is clear that we are basing our own actions, thoughts, & lives on following the way of Christ.

By using "Christ-follower", I think diminishes the negative connotations the word "Christian" can have & at the same time it helps focus us as "Christ-followers" on our true task. A "Christfollower's" purpose is to ultimately follow Christ so closely that that person embodies the teachings & actions of Christ, yet as a follower we know that the Sprit is always working on us to change us more into his likeness.

They are following but they can hardly hear Jesus and therefore he has very little, if any, effect on that person at all. And, of course, there are those people who are in between.

Using the word "Christ-follower" brings up one of the ultimate questions in our faith..."**How closely are you following Christ**?"
