What is an Assessment Center?

An intensive three day journey of discovery.

Through online testing, conversations, group sessions, interviews, and private consultations you will be assisted in discerning whether your gifts and strengths are a good match for church planting. You will be guided by experienced church planting leaders and counselors committed to helping you find your most rewarding ministry destination.

We'll have a group outing to the city and eat dinner together in downtown Seattle.

On the last day, each individual or couple will meet with the entire team. This final interview will be an opportunity to receive feedback from the assessors and discuss your own evaluation of your call to a church planting ministry as a result of the assessment process.

Why attend?

1. To discover and accurately assess your abilities, strengths and weaknesses measured against the demands of an effective church planting ministry.
2. To receive an objective affirmation of your calling and giftedness for church planting for yourself, your spouse and your sponsoring organization(s).
3. To develop a relational network among church planting peers, coaches and mentors.
4. To be encouraged and strengthened for the work of the harvest to which God has called you.

While not everyone who attends the Assessment Center will go on to a church planting ministry assignment, this experience has proven to be an excellent preparation for effective future ministry in any setting.

What about costs?

The cost is \$2,000/couple or \$1,800/individual. If you are married, your spouse must accompany you.

To reserve your place, a non-refundable deposit of \$500 is due at registration (payable to CEA). The balance can be paid upon check-in at the Assessment Center.

Cost includes all testing instruments, room accommodations (Monday and Tuesday evenings) and meals (Monday lunch through Wednesday breakfast) for the candidate couple and one accompanying sponsor.

If you need reservations for additional nights we are happy to provide recommendations.
