### Did you know...

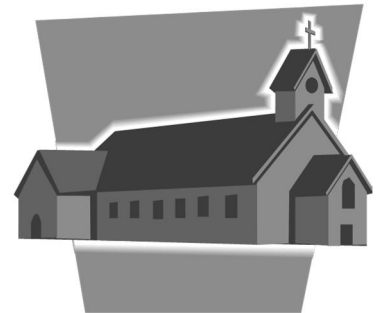


**\$3,250**

The amount given to **Salvation Army Community Table Program.** (This is the first distribution of 3 years). The milk has been well received. Last week one of the volunteers reported, one of the recipients response was 'thank you, this is the first milk I've had this week.' The milk is always delivered on Friday and any leftovers are handed out on Monday.

The amount given to **Wayman Chapel A.M.E.** located on Billings' south side. They will be able to add a second exit to the second floor of the parsonage and make three separate apartments in the building. They are very excited about this prospect because it allows them to do ministry with men who are employed but have no short term housing, it makes use of their parsonage building, and it provides the congregation with a little bit of regular income. They are also very excited about their "Community Breakfasts" which they hold once a month. These have been well attended by people in their neighborhood, and Pastor Robin has begun to do New Member classes upstairs after the breakfast for those who are interested in further their relationship with the church. Any money left over from our donation would be used to continue to fund those breakfasts. This gift to Wayman is doing exactly what we had hoped it would do: allowing people who are already engaged in ministry in areas where we are not involved to be strengthened by our support. It is reaching deeper into the community, and spreading the good news wider than we can on our own.

A van and extended warranty was purchased for this amount for **Rocky Boy Lutheran Church** on the Rocky Boy reservation. They are very pleased to have the van and our youth kids going on the YOLO Mission trip will get to see and put the van into action.

The amount donated to **Tumbleweed**, a program serving runaway and at-risk teens, to help purchase and install new flooring in their drop in center and additional items to update the area and make it more welcoming and appealing. The floor is beautiful!

They are purchasing some GED training and beginning keyboarding software, some parenting magazines, several sets of 15 of the same book to form book clubs, e-Readers loaded with books and art supplies.

We have notified **Habitat for Humanity** that ALC will be a house sponsor. We have been assigned house #69 to begin construction in October 2014. It will be in a new subdivision in the Heights. We are not only helping to build a house but changing the lives of a family for generations. This is a \$25,000 commitment due October 2014.
