Rest

Do you find yourself working every overtime shift? Are you frequently called in on your off time? If so, you might

be chronically tired, maybe even burning out. I've been there before, even to the point of unusual health issues such as shingles at the age of 30! As a deputy in Spokane County, I fell into a trap of work, work and more work. What I did not consider until after retirement was the need for frequent rest from the grind of being a first responder.

I retired and moved to La Pine in June of 2014 to pastor a church here. I still did not perceive my need for solitary rest until this year. I took a solo tour this June, hitting many remote parts of Oregon. That trek mentally rested and spiritually refreshed me more than any other.

There is Biblical evidence to show that Jesus recharged his batteries by being alone. Mark 6 is full of activity and tragedy. Amid all this, Jesus encourages his disciples in verse 31 to "come aside by yourselves to a deserted place and rest awhile." After their rest is interrupted by the feeding of the 5000, Jesus again sends his disciples away, and himself goes alone to a mountain to pray. Real rest from serving others is important to our overall health, and Jesus knows this. If He can take time away from the demands of being the Messiah, I can take time away from ministry demands and you can from public service. You won't regret it.
