Memorials were held in a number of locations throughout Central Oregon. Local news stations and newspapers cover the memorial services each year.

This past year Deschutes County Sheriff's Office installed a Law Enforcement Memorial flag pole. There are two plaques on the memorial. One of them has the Deschutes County Sheriff's Office emblem and reads "This memorial is dedicated on May 15, 2012 To Honor Those Who Have Died . . . Dedicated to Those Who Live and Serve" The other plaque has an American flag and reads "Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called sons of God.
