While we seek to teach your children about God, we know that no one has more influence on their lives than you. We want to partner with you to help them learn more about their Heavenly Father while providing them with a fun play environment full of friends and people who love them.

Our Check-In Process

- Step 1:** Completely fill out each box on the sign-in sheet so that we may best serve the needs of your child
- Step 2:** Grab a pager and note on the sign-in sheet the number of the pager you have so that the volunteers may contact you during service if necessary.
- Step 3:** Label your child's things (bottles, sippy cups, diaper bags, etc.)
- Step 4:** Inform volunteers of any special instructions you'd like them to adhere to concerning your child. The more we know, the better we can serve you and your little one!
- Step 5:** Hand your child over the counter to one of our workers (please avoid using the door in order to maintain a more secure environment), say I-love-yous and goodbyes, and release them to have a fun time with their friends while you enjoy service!

Our Wellness Policy

For the protection of all children, please do not bring your child to the Nursery if they exhibit any of the following:

Our Volunteers

If you are interested in volunteering in the Nursery, there is a place for you!

All volunteers fill out an application which includes a form that grants permission for a background check, a basic outline of expectations and Foursquare guidelines, and some space for you to tell us a little bit about yourself.

After this application has been reviewed, you'll be scheduled to serve on a Sunday with the overseer of the Nursery to help you settle in and answer any questions you may have.

To ensure that your little ones receive the best care, we adhere to a one volunteer to every three children ratio. If dropping your child off would put the nursery over its limit, it is asked that you either stay until more workers arrive/service ends or keep them with you.
