## UNTO US & CHILD IS BORN

#### HOLDING A NEWBORN BABY

Do yourself a favor this Christmas: make the Christmas story come alive! Make it real for yourself and those you know. How? Hold a newborn baby. Yes, you heard me correctly, hold a newborn baby. And as you do, peer deep into the face and eyes of that baby with awe and wonder. Take note of how that precious child is entirely dependent on you and trusts you with their safety. Look at how perfectly crafted their tiny hands are. Smell that newborn smell that will quickly be gone within a matter of days. Be mesmerized by the pure innocence of that baby. Listen to every sound that baby makes as he or she snuggles and squirms in your embrace. And as you take all of those senses and observations in, look one last time and say to yourself, "This is exactly how Jesus came into the world to save me." It should give you chills if you meditate long enough on that thought!

#### A CHILD IS BORN

Isaiah the Prophet said, "For to us a child is born, to us a Son is given, and the government will be on His shoulders. and He will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Of the greatness of His government and peace there will be no end. He will reign on David's throne and over His kingdom, establishing and upholding it with justice and righteousness from that time on and forever. The zeal of the LORD Almighty will accomplish this." (Isaiah 9:6-7) And then 700 years after that prophesy, Mary gave birth to a newborn baby boy. She held Him and looked at Him just as you do when you hold a baby for the first time. The moment had to be surreal as Joseph upheld his promise to stay with Mary as the Angel of the Lord informed him to do. So, Joseph too held the newborn baby with pure joy.

#### JESUS WAS ALWAYS THERE

Make sure that you don't miss this very important piece of the Christmas story: Jesus was always there. Only now, He had taken on a new form. For the first time in history, Jesus was wearing the skin that He had created in the Garden of Eden! Why? Because this was the only way to defeat sin and death. Listen again to how Paul described this moment, "Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to His own advantage; rather, He made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled himself by becoming obedient to death—even death on a cross!" (Philippians 2:6-8) Paul reminds us that though Jesus had everything, He gave it all up for the Mission. Paul also tells us to have the same mindset: humility, servanthood, mission-minded. Now go back and hold that newborn again and be marveled!
