## Junior Laymen National Basketball Tournament Host State & City Guidelines 2016

Basketball game site needs at least one each of the following:

1. Certified Athletic Trainer
2. Person Certified in CPR & AED
3. Registered Nurse
4. Scoreboard, Clock Operator and Scorekeeper
5. Six (6) basketballs
6. P.A. system for prayer

### Tournament Rules & Guidelines

1. The following needs to be sent to the Director of Junior Laymen four (4) weeks before the contest.
  - a. Waiver for each player
  - b. Roster for the team
2. All games will begin with prayer in a circle.
3. All games will be held on Monday afternoon with the Championship on Tuesday
4. Ages of players range from eight (8) years old through high school.
5. Players that do not attend class cannot play in the Championship Game.
6. Coaches will need proof of insurance for the players.
7. Team must have uniforms with legible numbers on jerseys.
8. Games will consist of sixteen (16) minute halves with a five (5) minute halftime. The clock will be running throughout the game, but will stop at two (2) minutes of the last half. Each team will have three (3) time outs - one thirty (30) second and two (2) full.

9. Two (2) technical fouls will result in ejection from the game. No dunking during warm up's.
10. All games will be played under National Federation Basketball rules.

### Registration & Requirement

1. All team members must be registered in the Allen Jordan Seminar and Discipleship.
2. Team fees must be paid at Mid-Winter Board Meeting.
3. Teams must attend the Luncheon.

## Allen Jordan Junior Laymen Seminars

The Allen Jordan Junior Laymen Seminars are held each year during the National Congress of Christian Education.

- The seminars are the teaching arms of the National Laymen.
- The seminars are designed to teach and equip laymen, laywomen and youth for the work of the ministries.
- The seminars are designed to help laymen meet the goals, objectives and mission of the National Baptist Laymen.
- Seminar topics will include topics to meet the needs of the problems experienced in today's church.

### National Junior Laymen Basketball Tournament and Bible Bowl

The basketball tournament and the bible bowl are comprised of representatives from the various state conventions during the National Baptist Congress of Christian Education.

## The National Bible Bowl

### Rules

1. The contest will be divided into two major parts:
  - a. Questions & Answers
  - b. Sword Drill
2. Questions will consist of events in the Bible, names, places, life of Christ and other Bible personalities.
3. There will be 4 six-minute quarters worth ten points for each correctly answered question.
4. The first and third quarters will be Questions & Answers. The second and fourth quarters will be Bible Drill.
5. A person appointed by the National President will put the questions together, and the questions will be presented to the convener just prior to the Bible Bowl in a sealed envelope.
6. Contestants' age must be eight (8) years or older; must be in high school or in graduating year.
7. There can only be one (1) contestant per State convention.
8. Each contestant must be a member of the National Laymen's Movement and registered in the Allen Jordan Seminar.

### Questions & Answers

The contestant that presses the buzzer/bell first will be allowed to answer the question. If the correct answer is given, the convener will move to the next question. If the answer is incorrect, the convener will repeat the question, only the contestant who failed to answer the question correctly the first time will not be allowed to answer. The question will not be thrown out; a full ten seconds will be allowed.

### Sword Drill

The same rules apply with the addition of the use of the Bible. All Bibles are to remain closed and all hands must be on the Bible; one hand on top and one hand on the bottom. The contestant cannot rest the Bible on the desk or table. When the convener says, "GO", the contestant must then find the scripture and then press the buzzer/bell.

NOTE: If a contestant is constantly pressing the buzzer/bell, prior to the convener having read the question in its entirety, he may be penalized, either by the convener or the judges. The penalty will be one of the following:

- a. Loss of points (minus 10 points for each infraction).
- b. Missing a turn(s) within the quarter.
- c. Missing the remainder of the quarter.

The contestant must be warned prior to the inception of any of the above.

Plaques and gifts will be awarded to the first, second, and third place contestants at the Missions in Education and Evangelism Luncheon.
