## Statement on Tragedy in Orlando, Florida

In response to the many questions and comments surrounding this horrific act of terror and hatred perpetrated upon the 49 victims who lost their lives and the 53 persons who were injured in Orlando Florida on Sunday morning, as President of the National Baptist Convention, USA, Inc., I am compelled to respond to this atrocity with a response rooted in the Word of our God and based on the premise that that which we seek to do in the context of this situation and indeed every situation that we face, is to find ways to express God's love and extend the life of Christ. The hallmark of the Christian faith is love as stated in John 13:35: "By this everyone will know that you are My disciples, if you love one another."
