Position Purpose:

The Director of Music leads the Church in developing a quality Christian music ministry that glorifies God. The person must work cooperatively under the supervision of the Senior Pastor to achieve the Church's Mission and Vision: "Doing Bold New Things to Connect Fayetteville and the World to Jesus Christ." (II Corinthians 5:17) In addition, the Director of Music must also be a committed, maturing Christian who has a personal relationship with Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior.

The Director of Music is a permanent full-time position with full benefits.

Qualifications:

Must have experience as a Minister of Music or Director.

- Must have a bachelor's degree in Choral or Instrumental Music, Music Theory, Music Composition, or Conducting. Must have course credits/experience in Piano/Organ Performance or Vocal/ Choir.
- Master's degree in music theory, music composition, or conducting preferred but not required.
- Ability to play piano and keyboard.
- Ability to play the Hammond organ strongly preferred but not required.
- Ability to play the pipe organ preferred but not required.
- Must have ability to adapt to flexible schedules, practices, etc.
- Supervisory experience preferred.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Must demonstrate an ability to communicate with others in a professional manner.
- Applicant must be eager to learn and adapt to performance changes as directed by the Senior Pastor.
- Must possess the ability and willingness to assume a creative leadership role.
- Must have experience in and be able to plan and produce special musical concerts and/or workshops.
- Must possess the ability to advance the needs of the music department over personal ego needs.
- Must possess the ability to work collaboratively with the senior pastor, staff, volunteers and members of First Baptist Church.

Responsibilities:

Subject to review and adjustment by the Senior Pastor, the following make up the major responsibilities of the Director of Music:

- Plan congregational services, including music selection, in coordination with the Senior Pastor.
- Must assume over-all responsibility for all choirs, (Sanctuary, Male Chorus, Youth Choir, Chamber Choir, Gospel Choir and Kids for Christ) ensembles, instrumentalists, and other related areas.
- Recruit, develop, and direct the various choirs;
- Conduct weekly choir rehearsals;
- Under the direction of the Pastor, assist with planning for Sunday worship services and other special services as required;

- Seeks to select and to use music which brings glory to God, is spiritually correct, and ministers to the congregation.
- Supervises, develops, and trains volunteers for their area of ministry.
- Oversees and assures maintenance and care of all equipment for his area of ministry.
- Evaluates and suggests equipment needs for his area of ministry.
- Coordinate AVL (audio, video, and lighting) support and resources.
- Coordinate the duplication of DVDs and CDs of Sunday morning service for library and shut-in ministries.
- Serve as music worship leader during services.

The finalists must be available for a scheduled weekend during which they will work with two choirs and a praise team, to access their level of proficiency. On Sunday morning, the candidate will lead the music portion of the worship service with a formal interview to follow.
