# Student Minister Position Description The Sanctuary Fellowship 2019

- Must be willing to minister in line with the vision of TSF.

## **Responsibilities**:

- Attend weekly worship services and special events at The Sanctuary Fellowship.
- Lead out in the organization, planning, & execution of the Sanctus Student Ministry.
- Prepare, plan, attend and/or teach weekly at Sanctus meetings.
- Lead the Summer Penitas Mission Trip:
- Lead a weekly discipleship group comprised of hand-picked students.
- Recruit, train, and love an adult leadership team to serve alongside you in the Sanctus Ministry.
- Set goals and be proactive.
- Prepare and execute an assimilation process for new and current students.
- Meet with supervisor one day per week for the purpose of sharpening leadership skills and walk with Christ.
- Students Minister's direct supervisor is the Family Pastor.
- Other duties as assigned.
- The Student Pastor is not responsible to personally execute all responsibilities, but he is responsible for outcomes of listed responsibilities.

- 40 hrs per week in regular duties.
- · Additional time and work as necessary or required.
- Off Fridays and Saturdays
