- Proficiency in managing budgets and organizational finances

- Spiritually mature and humbly led by the Holy Spirit, evidenced in outward authenticity
- Prioritizes spiritual life development & evangelism
- Strong Christian character and moral integrity

- Courageous, servant leader
- Compassionate and emotionally intelligent
- Possesses strong oral & written communication skills
