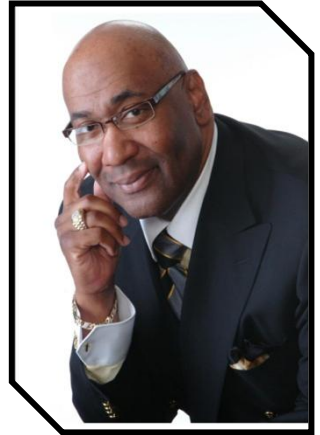
CONVENTION VICE PRESIDENT-AT-LARGE
