The Institute will be held with the National Baptist Congress of Christian Education, meeting in Detroit, MI, June 22-26. The 2015 Chaplains Institute will again feature two seminars which will highlight both theological and pastoral issues.

Seminar #1 ESCHATOLOGY: A personal look at Premillennial Theology. This Seminar will take the chaplains to Old and New Testament Scriptures that give prophetic insights concerning God's plans for the Second Coming of Jesus the Christ. While these discussions will recognize other predictions concerning the End Times, this seminar will focus on the Biblical basis for Premillennialism. The seminar will be led by the Rev. Dr. Robert N. Manzy, Pastor of the First Baptist Church of Little Rock, Arkansas. Dr. Manzy is a former U.S. Army Chaplain.
