Meet the Expository Preaching Conference Facilitators



Dr. D. Z. Cofield — A native New Yorker, Dr. Cofield has traveled across the world serving in the gospel of Jesus Christ. He earned a Masters Degree in Theology at the Dallas Theological and a PhD of Ministry Degree at Faith Evangelical Seminary in Tacoma, WA. In 1994, Dr. Cofield was chosen to serve as the 6th pastor of the Good Hope Missionary Baptist

Church in Houston, TX. . Dr. Cofield is a former instructor at Dallas Theological Seminary and a former adjunct professor at the College of Biblical Studies-Houston. He also teaches nationally and internationally in the areas of Christian Education, Expository Preaching, Pastoral Ministries, and Worship and Educational Leadership. Dr. Cofield has received numerous honors and awards including the Presidential Scholarship Award at Dallas Theological Seminary, the H. A. Ironside Award for excellence in expository preaching. He has written for several Christian publications, including Preaching Today, Leadership Journal and the African-American Pastors' Journal on Great Eulogies.



Pastor K. Edward Copeland — a minister of the Gospel of Jesus Christ who has been blessed with many talents and skills. He is a musician, composer, preacher, lecturer, author and attorney. He is most widely known for his unique gift to teach the Bible with supernatural clarity and simplicity. He has a passion for helping ministers and ministries develop to their

maximum potential. He is the author of "Riding in the Second Chariot", a guide for ministers and church leaders. Pastor Copeland graduated from the University of Illinois, Champaign-Urbana in 1984 with a BA in English/Rhetoric. He also earned a Masters of Divinity degree from Golden Gate Baptist Theological Seminary in Mill Valley, CA and is currently working on his PhD of Ministry at Trinity Evangelical Divinity School. He has been a lecturer for the National Baptist Convention of America, USA Inc. and many other conferences throughout the nation and across denominational lines. He is a board member of the National Evangelism Team and is a gifted trainer in the areas of evangelism, discipleship, youth ministry, sacred music, and men's ministry. He currently serves as pastor of New Zion Missionary Baptist Church in Rockford, IL.



Dr. Frank E. Ray, Sr. — one of America's most respected Bible teachers, is a native of TN. He received his Bachelor's, Master's of Science, and Doctorate degrees from Andersonville Theological Seminary in Camilla, GA. Dr. Ray's ministry springs from New Salem Missionary Baptist Church in Memphis, TN, where he has pastored for almost 40 years. He travels the length and breadth of

this country, spreading the gospel and fulfilling his commitment to bringing souls to Jesus Christ. Often referred to as the "walking Bible", he preaches the word of God with spirit-filled scriptural simplicity. Today the scope of 'God is Good Ministries' is worldwide and Dr. Ray's radio and television ministry is touching thousands of lives throughout the world. His leadership skills and constant study of God's word has earned him numerous honors, awards and appointments to national positions and is currently serving as the national lecturer for the same organization. He served for 10 years as chairman of the 'Late Night Services' for the National Baptist Convention USA, Inc. and is currently serving as the national lecturer for the same organization. In July 2002, he launched the first Frank Ray Expository Preaching, Teaching and Church Growth Conference.



Dr. R.A. Williams, Jr. — a native of Houston, TX, Dr. Williams obediently fulfills his calling as the proud Pastor of the McCoy Memorial Baptist Church located in Los Angeles, CA for more than 30 years.
