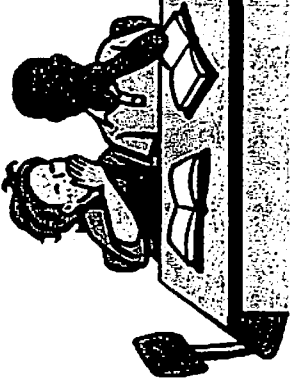
Remarks / Benediction

Afternoon Session at 2:00 – 4:00 p.m.

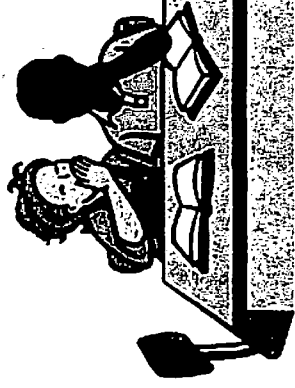
The afternoon session convened at 2:00 p.m. by singing “Praise Him”. Music was provided by Alice Clinton-Boyd(Des Moines, IA).

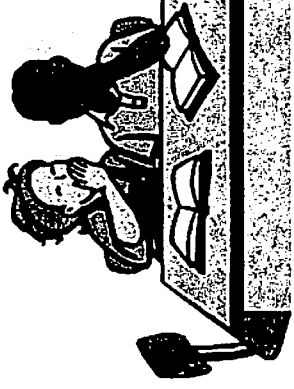

Title and Committee Responsibilities

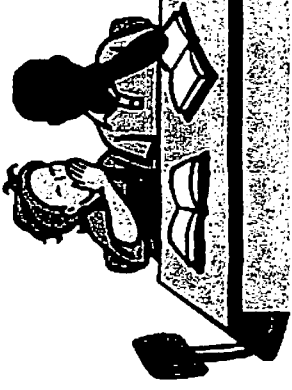

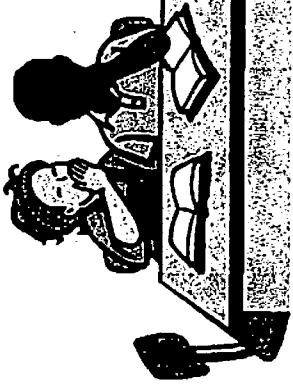
Clothing Chair – Responsible for the collection of clothing, sorting, display, area to receive clothing and set up for the special guests to shop. etc.

NBC young people donate shirts, jeans and packages of new underwear (girls donate for girls, boys donate for boys (can also include school supplies)).

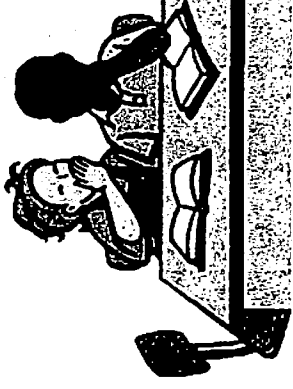

Secret Servants Chairperson – Responsible for overseeing the project and all committees

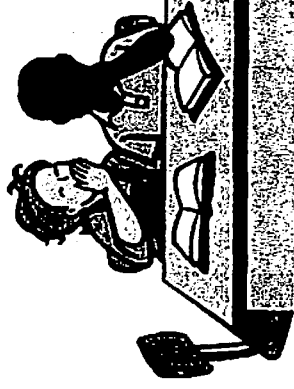
Note: Committee chairpersons should seek volunteers to help with their committees. Chairpersons should consist of an adult and young person.

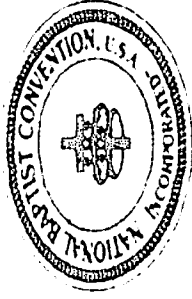
Luncheon Chair – Responsible for the menu, set-up, decorations, area to serve lunch etc.

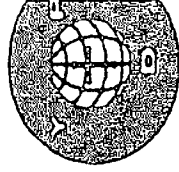
Title and Committee Responsibilities

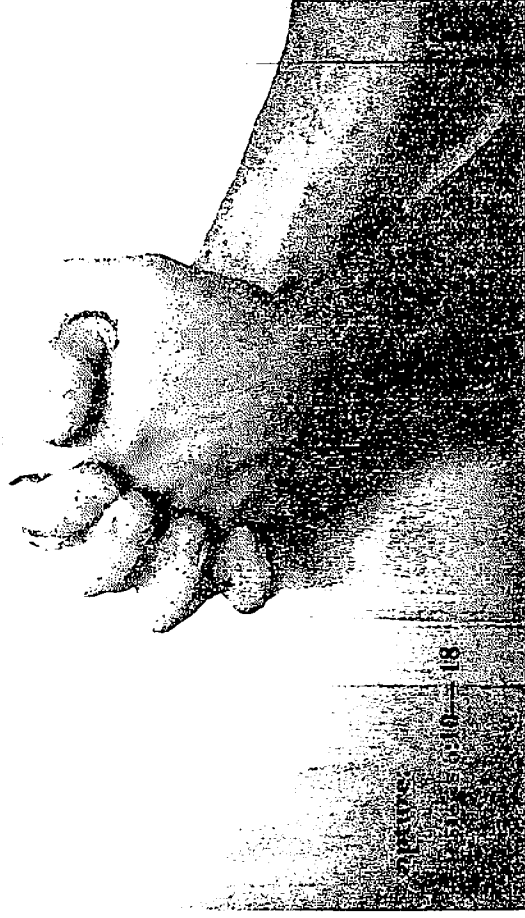
Prayers: He that Dwelleth In the Secret Place.....
Psalms 91

1. He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.
2. I will say of the Lord, He is my refuge and fortress, my God; in Him will I trust
3. Surely He shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler, and from the noisome pestilence.
4. He shall cover thee with His feathers, and under His wings shalt thou trust: His truth shall be thy shield and buckler.
5. Thou shalt not be afraid for the terror by night; nor for the arrow that flieth by day.
6. Nor for the pestilence that walketh in darkness; nor the destruction that wasteth at noonday.
7. A thousand shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand; but it shall not come nigh thee.
