(Clermont, FL) and Central Florida Reception Center (Orlando, FL).

Who: Prison Ministry and Criminal Justice Commission (PMCJC) members and leaders and constituents of congregations of the National Baptist Convention, USA, Inc., (NBCUSA) who must undergo a one (1) hour prison ministry orientation, submit volunteer applications and pass security screening.

In order to coordinate and strengthen ministry efforts, the PMCJC Executive Secretary is asking that the NBCUSA Laymen Movement, Music Auxiliary, Women's Auxiliary, Late Night Services, Congress of Christian Education, Evangelistic Board, Home Missions Board, and Foreign Missions Board designate at least two (2) persons to participate in this worthwhile ministry. The Music Auxiliary is asked to provide a praise team to lead the music ministry each night. Aftercare Ministry, to include baptism, counseling, and preaching and worship services will be established with Florida area churches.

Benevolent and evangelistic outreach has shown that prisoners who receive or engage in life changing religious experiences regularly are less likely to recidivate once released from prison.
